Person-Centered Approach vs Medical Model of Care

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Dual Role of Nursing Homes



A place where people receive needed health care and assistance with ADLs



a place they call "HOME"



Medical Model

- Task-oriented, routine driven
- Focus is on problems
- Residents frequently have different care staff
- Management makes most decisions without input from residents, families, or direct-care staff

Why is person-centered care important?

- Respect for individuality
- Enhanced quality of life
- Promotes autonomy and independence
- Improves health outcomes



Person-Centered Approach

Reduces behavior problems Fosters positive relationships

Encourages family involvement

Staff satisfaction and retention



Person-Centered Model

- Organizational support of PCC—Systemic change
- 2 Staff alter their work routines to honor residents' preferences
- Management seeks input from resident, families, and staff before making decisions that affect the residents' daily lives



Implementation

- Requires examining systems that are barriers to person-centered care
- Comprehensive Resident Assessments
- Involving Residents and Families in Care Planning
- Creating personalized routines
- Adapting the physical environment
- Empowering and training staff
- Adapting care for those with cognitive impairments
- Continuous evaluation and improvement



Regulatory Support of Person-Centered Approach

- CMS—The Reform of Requirements for LTC Facilities (2016)
 - Key provisions: resident-centered careplans, choice and autonomy, communication and participation
- Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement (QAPI) Program
 - Regular assessment and improvement
- Person-Centered Care Focus in Care Compare and Five-Star System
- The Older Americans Act (OAA)
 - Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program
