Scientific Training in Oncology (STRONG) Post-Baccalaureate Program

About the Program

The American Cancer Society (ACS) has awarded the OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center the Diversity in Cancer Research Post-Baccalaureate Fellows Program grant to fund the American Cancer Society Scientific Training in Oncology (STRONG) Program. STRONG aims to increase diversity in the cancer research workforce by increasing the number of under-represented groups in the biomedical field. The goal of this program is to expose scholars to cancer research and provide career development activities that will help them prepare for a career in cancer research, prevention, or treatment. The STRONG program is designed as a two-year cancer research experience for individuals with a bachelor's degree who intend to pursue a doctoral degree in biomedical science, data science, population health, public health, medicine, or other health profession. The program will pay a stiped of \$35,000 per year.
